

AUTHORSHIP CONTRIBUTIONS

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1. The authorship requires minimum 2 or 3 types of contributions listed in the table below (CSE)
2. It is mandatory for all authors to draft manuscript or to critically revise manuscript for important intellectual content (ICMJE)
3. All authors are responsible for final approval of the version to be published (ICMJE)
4. Authors should meet listed conditions 1, 2, and 3
5. Investigators who do not meet the required number of contributions or criteria should be listed in acknowledgement part (ICMJE)

Type of contribution	Explanation	Author(s) name(s)
CONCEPT	The idea for the research or article, framing the hypothesis	
DESIGN	Planning the methods to generate results	
SUPERVISION	Oversight and responsibility for the organization and course of the project and the manuscript	
RESOURCES	Dollars, equipment, space, personnel vital to the project	
MATERIAL	Biological materials, reagents, referred patients	
DATA COLLECTION &/or PROCESSING	Responsibility for doing experiments, managing patients, organizing and reporting data	
ANALYSIS &/or INTERPRETATION	Responsibility for making sense of and presenting the results	
LITERATURE SEARCH	Responsibility for this necessary function	
WRITING	Responsibility for creating all or a substantive part of the manuscript	
CRITICAL REVIEW	Reworking the manuscript for intellectual content before submission, not just spelling and grammar checking	
OTHER	For novel contributions
